1.1 Good news and celebrations:

- 1st grade has students moving up levels in acceleration groups and exiting from RTI

- Good growth on MAP assessments

- Resource teachers are collecting data
- Kindergarten started acceleration groups

1.2 Review and approval of December Minutes

● **1.3 New Items**

- Status Check 2
 - MAP math achievement in 47th %ile, up from the 36th %ile last year
 - MAP reading achievement in 44th %ile, up from 38th %ile last year
 - Trajectory for school performance goal #1 for MAP achievement is on track for spring for both subjects.
 - Trajectory for school performance goal #2 for PLC monitoring is on track for spring
 - Trajectory for school performance goal #3 for decreasing chronic absenteeism isn't as on track. The current percentage is at the same percentage for chronic absenteeism as this time last year.

- We have no COSA seats for next year, but current students are grandfathered in.
- Budget Slideshow
 - enrollment trends are going down districtwide
 - projected enrollment declines districtwide, but projected enrollment increases for Thorpe
 - funding based on student enrollment
 - no class size reduction ratios exist anymore
 - projected budgets shouldn't change much from now to fall
- New Budget Items
 - already is replacing MAP assessments next year, so we want to purchase the program for individualized skill practice based on assessment results
 - Title I funds
 - RSC stays
